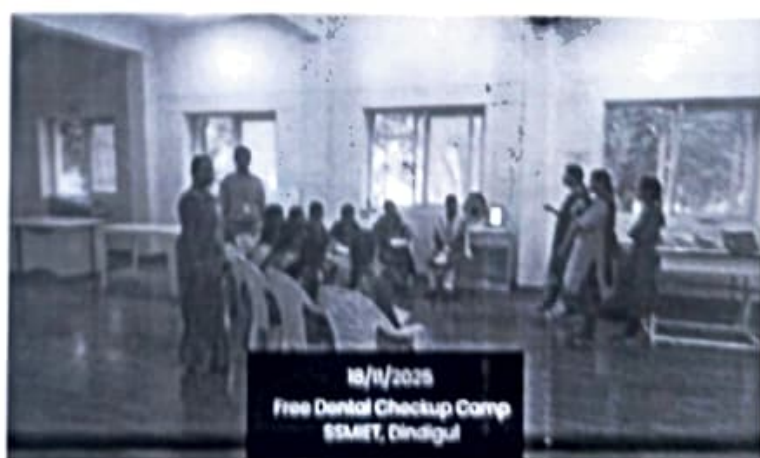
Conclusion:
