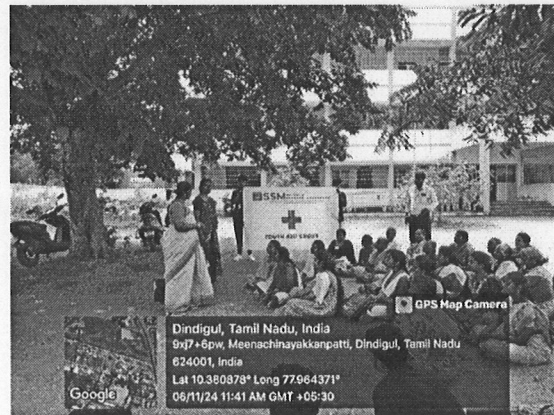
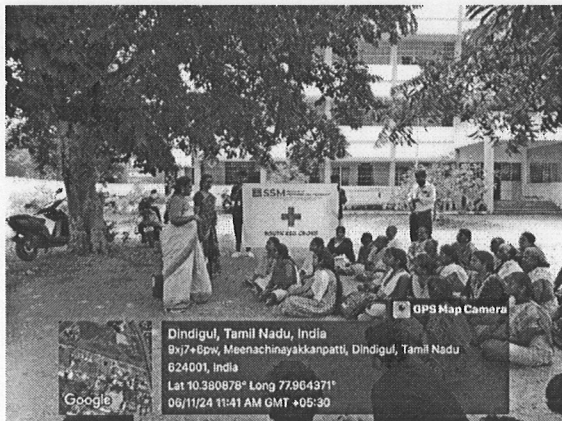
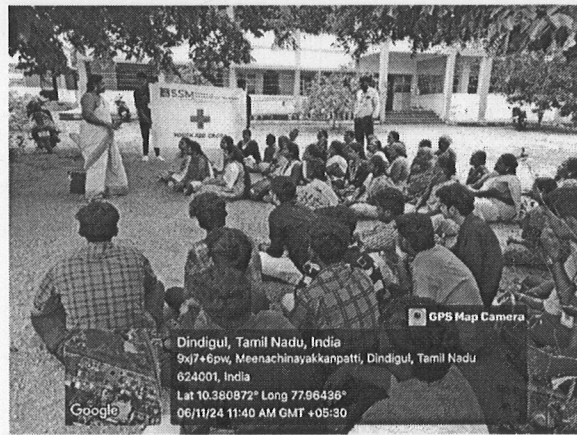
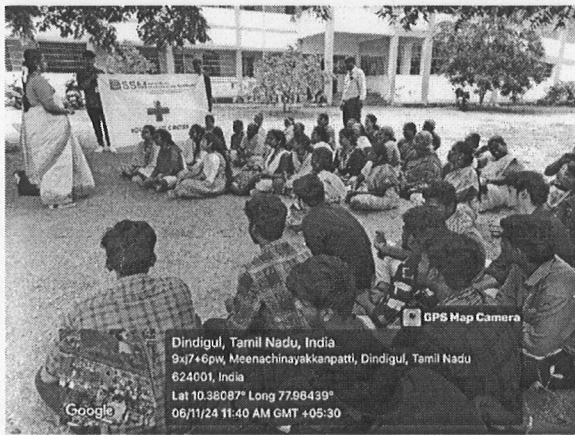
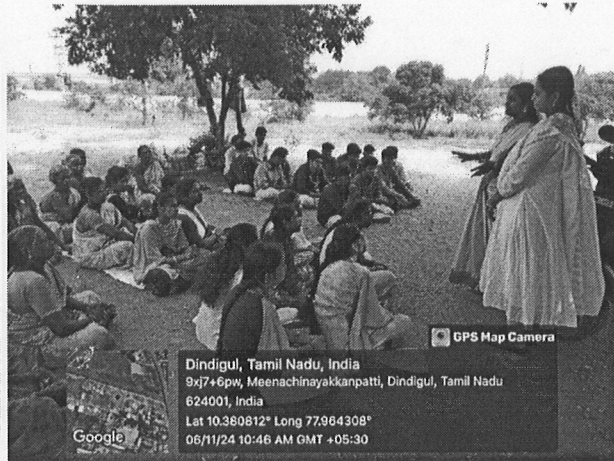
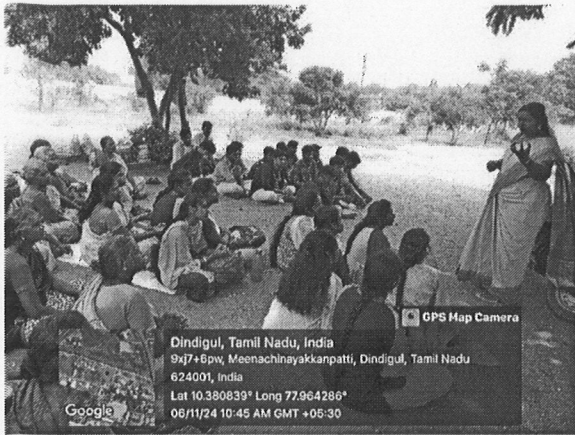
In the training session, Dr. S. Haripriya started the afternoon session with the importance of making candle. Candles are mass consumption items and are widely used for lighting and

illumination in household, churches, and restaurants etc., the demand for candle is increasing day by day due to its various usages. Artistic and decoration candles also have very good potential.

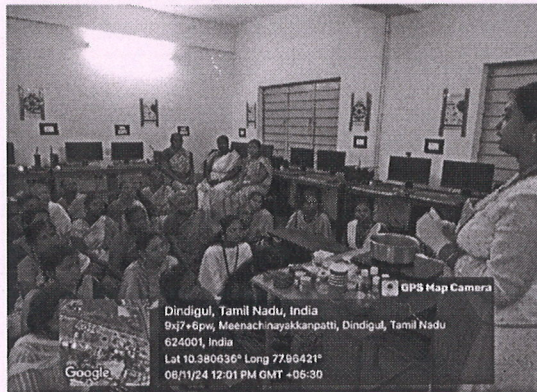
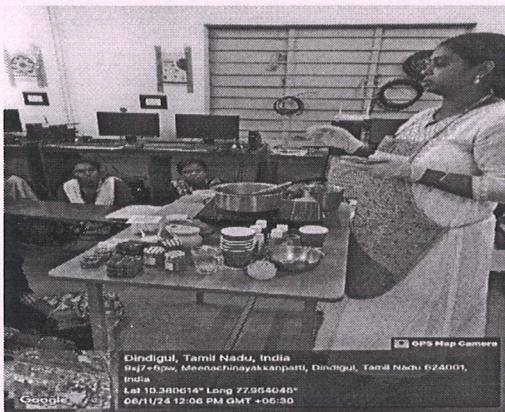
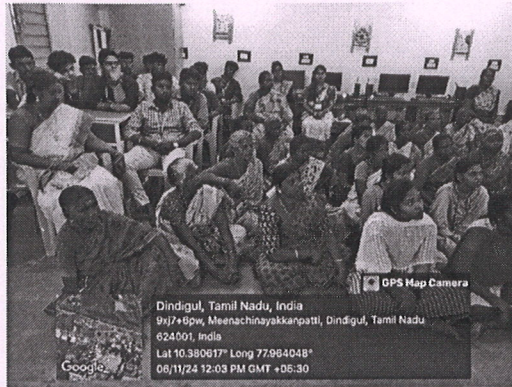
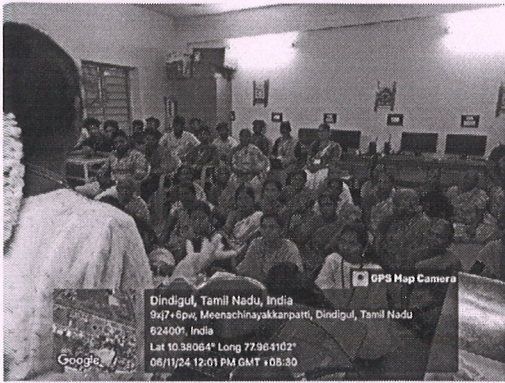
