## HOUSEHOLD SURVEY REPORT

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) is a flagship programme initiated by the Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India, with an objective to bring transformational change in rural development processes by leveraging knowledge institutions to help build inclusive and sustainable communities.

As part of this initiative, our institution has adopted nearby villages to assess their socio-economic status, understand local challenges, and identify development opportunities through direct engagement and field-level surveys.

This report presents the findings of a **Household Survey** conducted from **19th to 21st February 2025** in the following five villages:

- Kamachipuram
- Solaraja Colony
- Kurumbapatti
- Angammal Nagar
- Ramayan Patti

A total of **860 households** were surveyed by **170 student volunteers**, guided by faculty members. The survey aimed to gather baseline information on various aspects such as health, sanitation, education, livelihoods, access to basic amenities, and awareness of government schemes.

The insights from this report are expected to serve as a foundation for developing actionable plans and policy recommendations for rural development under the UBA framework.

## Survey Objectives

- To collect baseline socio-economic and demographic data of households
- To assess the availability and access to basic amenities (electricity, water, sanitation, education, healthcare)
- To identify key areas for village development interventions under UBA framework
- To promote awareness of government schemes among rural households

## Methodology

- The survey was conducted by 170 students in groups, each assigned to different areas within the villages.
- Each group was guided by a faculty/staff coordinator.
- Each household was surveyed using the standard UBA format covering aspects such as:
  - Family Details
  - Education and Occupation
  - Source of Income
  - Health and Sanitation
  - Access to Electricity and Drinking Water
  - Agricultural Practices
  - Government Scheme Awareness
