Entrepreneurial Traits of Women Entrepreneurs Following are main entrepreneurial traits of women entrepreneurs:

- Imagination: It refers to the imaginative approach or original ideas with competitive market. Well planned approach is needed to examine the existing situation and to identify the entrepreneurial opportunities. It further implies that women entrepreneurs have association with knowledgeable people and contracting the right organizations offering support and services.
- Persistence: Women entrepreneurs must have an intention to fulfill their dreams. They have to make a dream translated into an enterprise. Studies show that successful women have worked hard. They persisted in getting loan from financial institutions and other inputs. They have persisted in adverse circumstances and in adversity.
- Attribute to Work Hard: Enterprising women have further ability to work hard. The imaginative ideas have to come to a fair play. Hard work is needed to build up an enterprise.
- Ability and Desire to Take Risk: The desire refers to the willingness to take risk and ability to the proficiency in planning, making forecast, estimates and calculations. Profits are the reward of risk. Enterprising women take risk, but the risk is well calculated. It offers challenges where chances of survival and failure are on equal footing.



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Motivating Factors of Woman Entrepreneurs

There are four motivating factors which influence a woman entrepreneur:

- Recognition: A woman entrepreneur is motivated by recognition in respect of admiration, regard, esteem and celebrity. It is communication tools that reinforce and rewards the most important outcomes entrepreneurs create for the business. Profit: It is not the true motivation which influences an entrepreneur. Welfare of the employees, payment of tax to the government, is indirectly improving the living conditions of the entrepreneur. Thus, the real motivation for Apple to create and sell popular products like iPod, iPhone and iPad is probably not money, but the interest.
- Influence: It is the capacity or power of a person to be a compelling force on or produce effects on the actions, behavior, opinions etc. of others.
- Internal Motivation: It is the main factor which motivates businesswomen. It is the internal factors which are very important for the motivation. It includes creativity, respect, and happiness of other people.

The engaging Q&A session broke down obstacles and stigmas related to talking about women entrepreneurs and encouraged candid conversation on delicate subjects.

International Women's Day- 2025 Celebrations


International Women's Day 2025 was celebrated in our college on 12.03.2025, on behalf of the Women Empowerment Cell.

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


Fig.2. Resource Person's Speech

The Women Empowerment Cell of SSM Institute of Engineering and Technology organized An Insightful session titled "A Doctor's Guide to Health and Self-Care for Young Women" on 07.10.2024 (Monday) in Seminar Hall 3, with the objective of educating and empowering young women on important health issues and self-care practices. The talk was led by Dr.Selvarani Jeyaraman, Managing Director - Srii Amogam Hospital, a renowned healthcare professional with expertise in women's health. It aimed to address the common health concerns faced by young women, promote healthy lifestyle choices, and equip participants with knowledge on maintaining physical and mental well-being. The girl students of IV Year of all Departments of SSMIET had attended the session.

The program commenced at 11:00 AM in Seminar Hall 3 with the Tamizh Thai Vazhthu, followed by the welcome address by K.Vikashini of IV Year ECE and the introduction of the chief guest by K.Shreenithi of IV Year ECE. The chief guest was honoured by Dr. S. Karthigai Lakshmi, Dean (Academics), and Dr. C. Sujatha, Dean (School of Computing).

The session was then handed over to the speaker of the day, during which the following points were addressed.

Key Points Discussed:

- 1. **Understanding Female Health:** The session began with an overview of the unique health needs of young women. Topics covered included menstrual health, hormonal balance, reproductive health, and the importance of routine check-ups like gynecological visits and breast self-examinations.
- 2. **Nutrition and Diet:** Dr.Selvarani Jeyaraman emphasized the significance of a balanced diet rich in essential nutrients such as iron, calcium, and vitamins. Special focus was given to understanding the role of diet in hormonal health and energy levels. Participants were also educated on how to develop healthy eating habits that align with their lifestyle and health goals.
- 3. **Mental Health Awareness:** Mental well-being was a major topic of discussion, as young women often face stress, anxiety, and societal pressures that can impact their mental health. The speaker provided strategies to manage stress, improve mental resilience, and seek professional help when needed.
- 4. **Exercise and Physical Fitness:** Regular physical activity was highlighted as a cornerstone of health. The speaker recommended incorporating a mix of cardiovascular, strength training, and flexibility exercises. Young women were encouraged to adopt a fitness routine that is enjoyable and sustainable.
- 5. **Self-Care Practices:** Dr.Selvarani Jeyaraman introduced the concept of self-care beyond physical health, focusing on emotional self-care, the importance of setting boundaries, and taking time for activities that nurture the mind and soul.
- 6. **Preventive Health Measures:** The session emphasized the importance of preventive health care, including vaccinations, regular health screenings, and safe practices for reproductive health.

Interactive Q&A Session:

Following the presentation, an interactive Q&A session allowed participants to ask questions and clarify doubts. Queries ranged from managing menstrual irregularities to mental health support and tips for maintaining work-life balance. Dr.Selvaraní Jeyaraman addressed each question with practical advice and shared resources for further guidance.

Impact and Takeaways:




The session was highly interactive, with students actively engaging in discussions and asking insightful questions. This engagement fostered a sense of community among participants and enriched the learning experience.


